Proverbs 1:5

- 1. It will give increased understanding.
- 2. It will give wise counsel.

# PROVERBS HAS A PERSPECTIVE.

Proverbs 1:7-9

- A. A lesser source of wisdom
- B. The greatest source of wisdom
  - 1. Developing a <u>reverence</u> for God
  - 2. What does reverence for God look like?
    - a. He is to be obeyed.
    - b. He is to be <u>served</u>.
